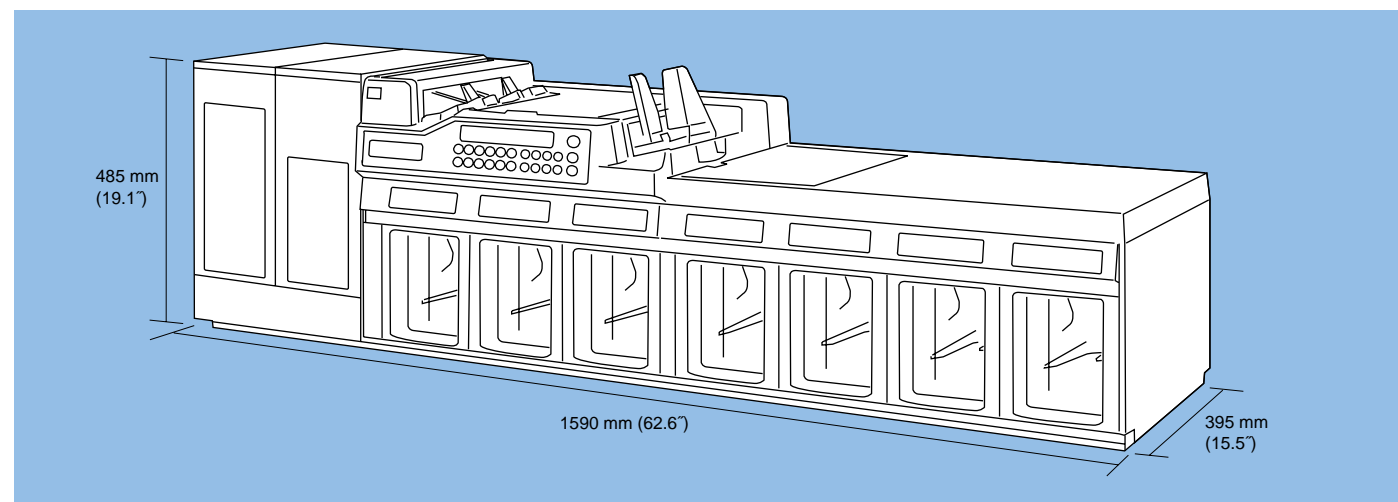

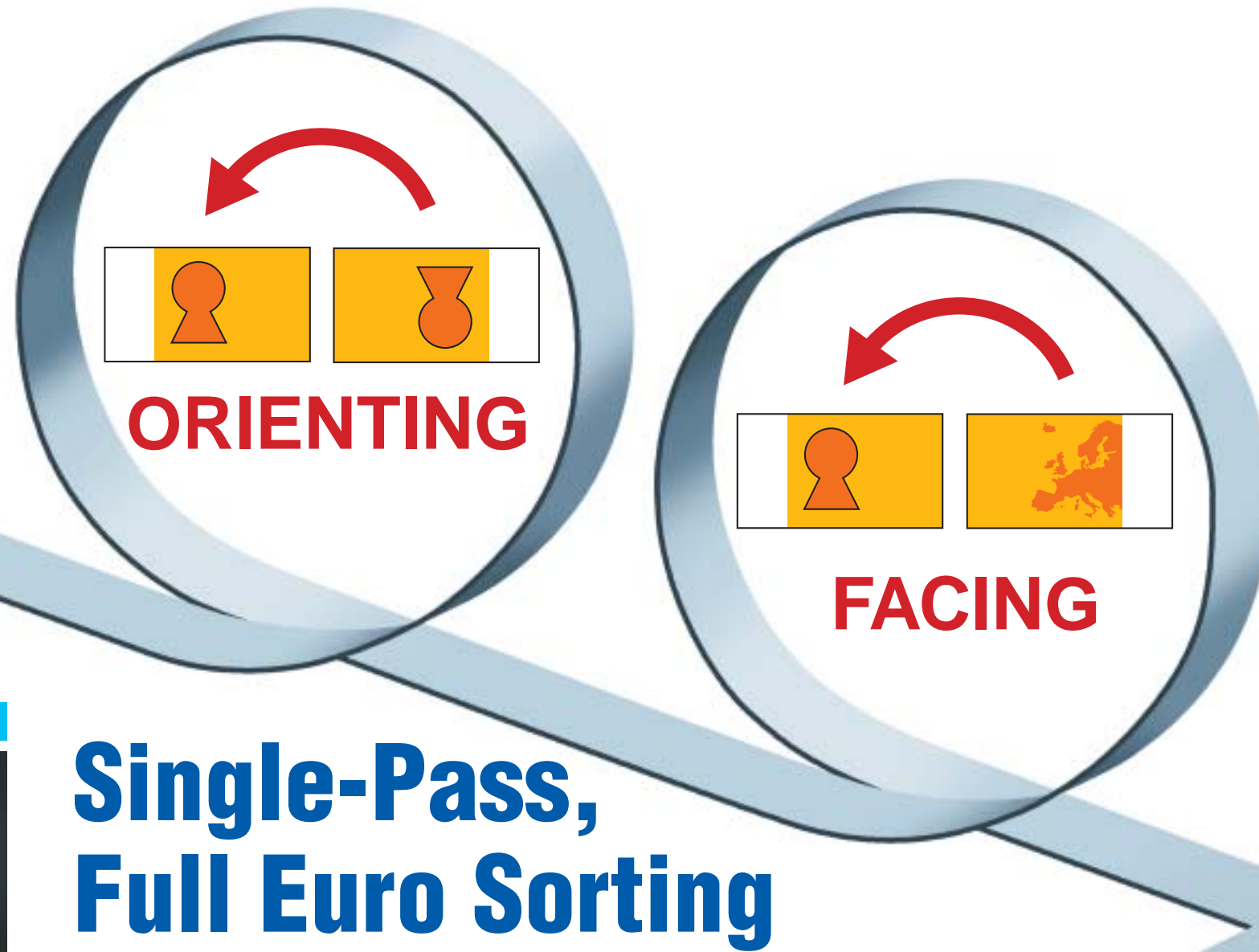

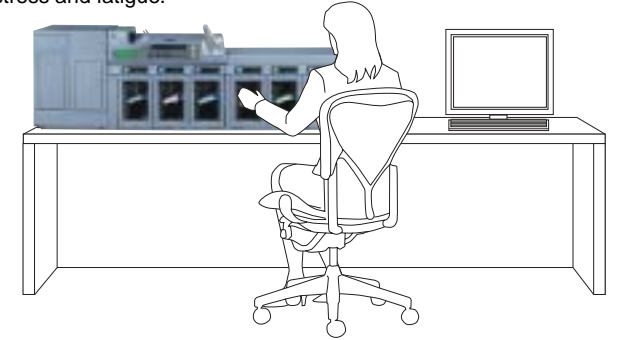
Innovative Flipper Module for Automatic Orientation

- The UW-270 incorporates GLORY's originally developed flipper module. This unique mechanism automatically and instantaneously aligns all banknotes of different directions into a single designated direction.

- The UW-270 is equipped with seven stackers and offers single-pass processing, yet is small enough to sit on a desktop.
- The easy-to-use UW-270 minimises operator action, so there's less stress and fatigue.

"SORT" Mode (Denomination/Orientation)	The mixed banknotes are oriented in the same direction and sorted by denomination to dedicated stackers.
"FIT" Mode	This mode sorts each banknote as ATM-fit, Teller-fit or unfit. It is also possible in this mode to arrange banknotes in a specified direction.
"COUNT" Mode	This mode is used to count the actual number of banknotes, without regard to denomination.

Sorts All Euro Denominations with a Minimum of Stackers

- Using sorters that do not have automatic facing and orienting functions, it could theoretically take as many as 28 stackers to sort all seven Euro denominations in a single pass. The UW-270 performs face/orientation sorting and discharges aligned banknotes onto the seven stackers by denomination.
